Imperial Beach Blvd. Sewer Repair Update

Please be advised that the excavation for the sewer repairs has subsequently become larger than expected. As a precautionary measure, the WESTBOUND lanes on IMPERIAL BEACH BLVD will be CLOSED TO THRU TRAFFIC between EMORY ST and 9TH ST. The temporary closure will be in effect until the contractor has backfilled and repaved the road, which is anticipated to be late afternoon tomorrow, 2/10/12.
