EXECUTIVE SUMMARY:

City Council approved 4th of July fireworks to be produced by Pyro Spectaculars, Inc. This action authorizes the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the Port of San Diego through a Right of Entry Permit granting access to the Imperial Beach Pier for Pyro Spectaculars, Inc. to produce the 4th of July Fireworks Show.

The fiscal impact of this action is an expense of \$1,208 to the Port of San Diego to process the Right of Entry Permit, and \$50 to the County Assessor for the CEQA processing fee.

BACKGROUND:

On June 4, 2014 City Council approved a fireworks show produced by Pyro Spectaculars, Inc. to be launched from the Imperial Beach Pier. All of the necessary permits and agreements are either complete or in process.

ANALYSIS:

Pyro Spectaculars, Inc. will require access to the Imperial Beach Pier to stage and produce the 4th of July Fireworks Show. This requires approval of the Port of San Diego in the form of a Right of Entry Permit. This action will authorize the City Manager to sign the permit granting pier access to Pyro Spectaculars, Inc. for the staging and production of the fireworks display.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION:

Based upon the above description and the temporary nature of the event, the project is determined to be Categorical Exempt to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Sections 15304 (Class 4 – Minor Alterations to Land) and/or 15323 (Class 23 – Normal Operations of Facilities for Public Gatherings) because it is a temporary event that would not involve the removal of mature, scenic trees or have any permanent effects on the

environment. The City has partnered with the Port of San Diego for CEQA and California Coastal Commission issues.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The fiscal impact of this action is an expense of \$1,208 paid to the Port of San Diego for the Right of Entry Permit, and \$50 paid to the San Diego County Assessor for CEQA fees, each from Account 101-1120-412.20-06 Professional Services.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the City Council adopt Resolution Number 2014-7500 authorizing the City Manager to enter into an agreement with the Port of San Diego through a Right of Entry Permit granting access to the Imperial Beach Pier for Pyro Spectaculars, Inc. to produce the 4th of July Fireworks Show.

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-7500

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IMPERIAL BEACH, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE PORT OF SAN DIEGO THROUGH A RIGHT OF ENTRY PERMIT GRANTING PIER ACCESS TO PYRO SPECTACULARS, INC. TO PRODUCE THE 4TH OF JULY FIREWORKS.

WHEREAS, the Imperial Beach City Council approved an agreement with Pyro Spectaculars, Inc. to produce a 4th of July Fireworks Show from the Imperial Beach Pier; and

WHEREAS, Pyro Spectaculars will require access to the pier to stage, launch and clean-up after the show; and

WHEREAS, the Port of San Diego requires a Right of Entry Permit for such activities on the pier; and

WHEREAS, the City of Imperial Beach is sponsoring the fireworks show.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Imperial Beach as follows:

1. Authorizes the City Manager to enter into an agreement through a Right of Entry Permit to allow Pyro Spectaculars, Inc. to produce the 4th of July Fireworks Show.
2. Approves the required payments totaling \$1,258 to be made from Account 101-1120-412.20-06 for the fees associated with obtaining this Permit.
