9.32.010 GENERALLY:

It is unlawful for any person, firm, association, or corporation to disturb the peace, quiet, and comfort of the community or any portion thereof or neighborhood therein by creating or causing to be created any unreasonably loud or disturbing noises in the City of Imperial Beach.

9.32.020 PROHIBITED NOISES:

The following noises, among others, are declared to be disturbing to the peace, quiet, and comfort of that portion of the community or neighborhood wherein they are created and in violation of Section 9.32.010. Such enumeration, however, shall not be deemed or construed as in any degree exclusive, but merely illustrative, it being the intent and purpose of this section to include and prohibit all noises of the character described in Section 9.32.010.

J. SOUND AMPLIFYING DEVICES OUTSIDE WITHOUT PERMIT:

The using, operating, or permitting to be played, used or operated any radio receiving set, musical instrument, phonograph, television, or other machine or device for producing, reproducing, or amplifying of sound wholly or partially outside of a completely enclosed building in such a manner as to disturb the comfort and repose of any person residing or working in the vicinity without the permit required by Section 9.32.030 or within the exemption provided by Section 9.32.050.

9.32.030 SOUND AMPLIFICATION PERMIT—REQUIRED—APPLICATION:

Any person, firm, or corporation desiring to engage in the activity described in subsection J of Section 9.32.020 shall submit an application for a permit to the Administrative Services Department stating the name and address of the applicant, the name and address of the person who will be in the immediate charge of the activity at the time and place of the activity, the location of the activity, a description of the location and the method of conducting the activity accompanied by the written permission of the owner of the location for the conduct of the activity, and an application fee in the sum of ten dollars. The application will be forwarded to the Captain of the Sheriff's Department who shall make such investigation, as he deems necessary and transmit his recommendation and the application to the City Manager for approval or disapproval.

9.32.040 SOUND AMPLIFICATION PERMIT—ISSUANCE—TERMS:

If the City Manager approves the application, the Administrative Services Department shall issue the permit subject to such conditions as the City Manager may deem necessary to carry out the intent of this chapter including, but not limited to, the furnishing of a faithful performance bond guaranteeing that all ordinances of the City and all laws of the State will be complied with and indemnifying the City for any expenses that may be incurred incident to the repair, removal of debris, cleaning up, and law enforcement in the vicinity of the activity or caused by the activity.

9.32.050 EXEMPTIONS—PERMIT:

A. Civic functions such as, but not limited to, parades, band concerts, athletic contests, and other public gathering may be exempt from the provisions of this chapter upon receiving a permit from the City Manager in accordance with the provisions of the section.

B. Any person or organization desiring to obtain an exemption from the provisions of this chapter shall make a written application to the City Manager fifteen days prior to the proposed conduct of the activity requiring such exemption. The application shall contain a detailed description of the proposed activity including, but not limited to, the name and address of the sponsoring person or organization, the name and address of the person responsible for conducting the activity and the location of the activity, and the number of persons expected to attend the activity. Upon receiving an application, the City Manager shall conduct an investigation and either grant or deny the application within five business days of receiving the application. The City Manager may grant a permit for a single event or for a schedule of events. If the City Manager denies an application, such denial shall be in writing stating the reasons for the denial. In the event the City Manager denies an application; the applicant may, by a written communication to the City Council, request that the City Council considers the matter at the next regularly scheduled meeting of the City Council. The City Council may hear the matter and either grant or deny the application. The decision of the City Council shall be final.

BY WAY OF APPLICATION THE PERMITTEE AGREES TO ABIDE BY ALL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE PERMIT ISSUED BY THE CITY OF IMPERIAL BEACH AND THE ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS LISTED BELOW:

1. No alcoholic beverages may be served to any person under the age of 21 years.
2. All amplified music must cease at 10:00 P.M.
3. The permits obtained may be revoked by order of the on-duty Sheriff’s supervisor at any time.
4. Permittees agree to clean up all remnants of the party and will be subject to all costs incurred by the City of Imperial Beach for such clean up if necessary.
