SUBJECT: 2012 Regional Beach Sand Project Construction Notification

This notice is to inform you that the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) will be constructing a regional beach nourishment project starting this month in the City of Imperial Beach. The Regional Beach Sand Project (RBSP) will place more than 1.4 million cubic yards of sand on beaches from Oceanside to Imperial Beach. This clean beach quality sand is dredged from three offshore borrow sites and placed on regional beaches. The 2012 RBSP will provide environmental, economic, and recreational benefits for residents and visitors alike.

The RBSP Imperial Beach receiver site will receive more than 400,000 cubic yards of sand. The project footprint will extend along the beach from the south end of Seacoast Drive where the revetment or rock wall ends, move north toward the pier, and end just south of the pier. Construction will occur 24 hours per day, 7 days a week. Placement of material is currently scheduled to occur in late August/early September 2012 and last approximately 30 days. Mobilization of equipment will occur approximately two to three weeks prior to placement of sand and demobilization of equipment will occur immediately following placement.
